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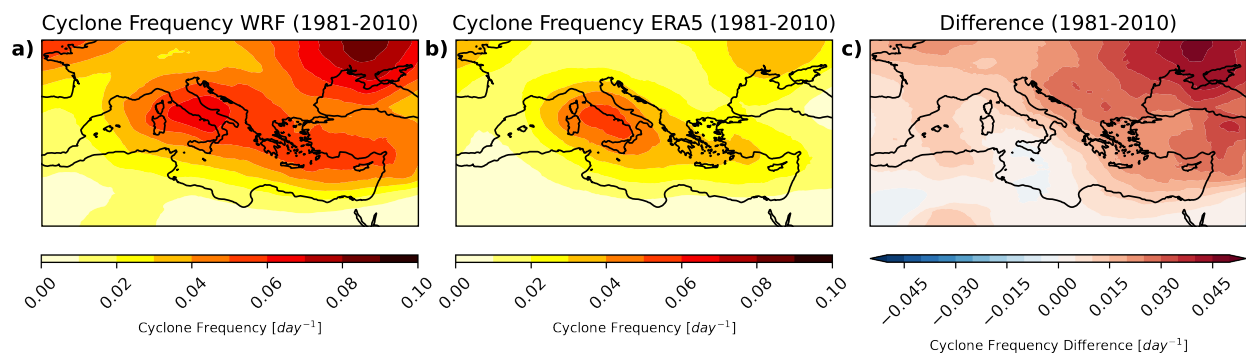


Figure S1. Same as Fig. 2, but now we compare the cyclone frequency between WRF (a) and ERA5 (b) and their difference for the period 1981-2010

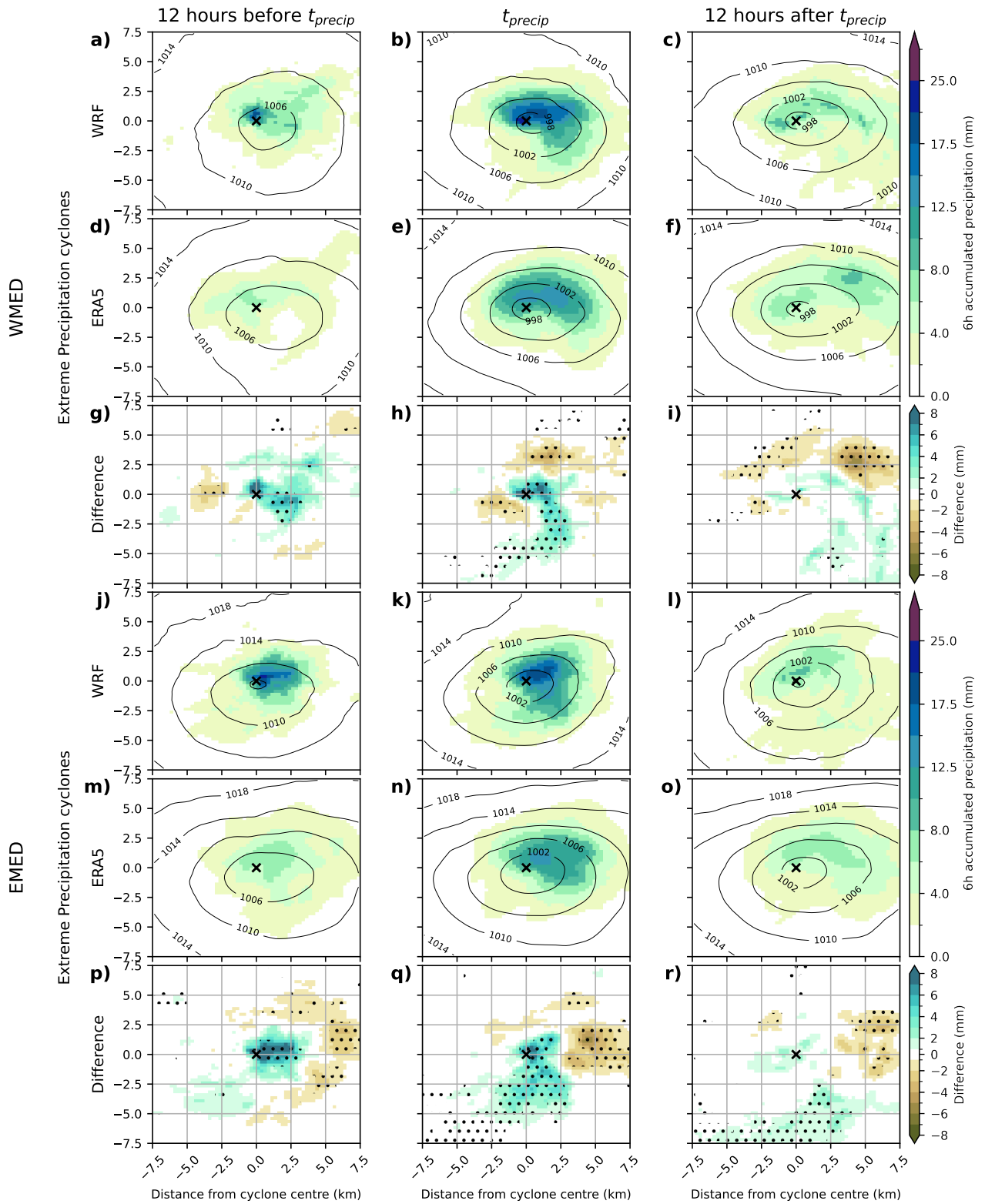

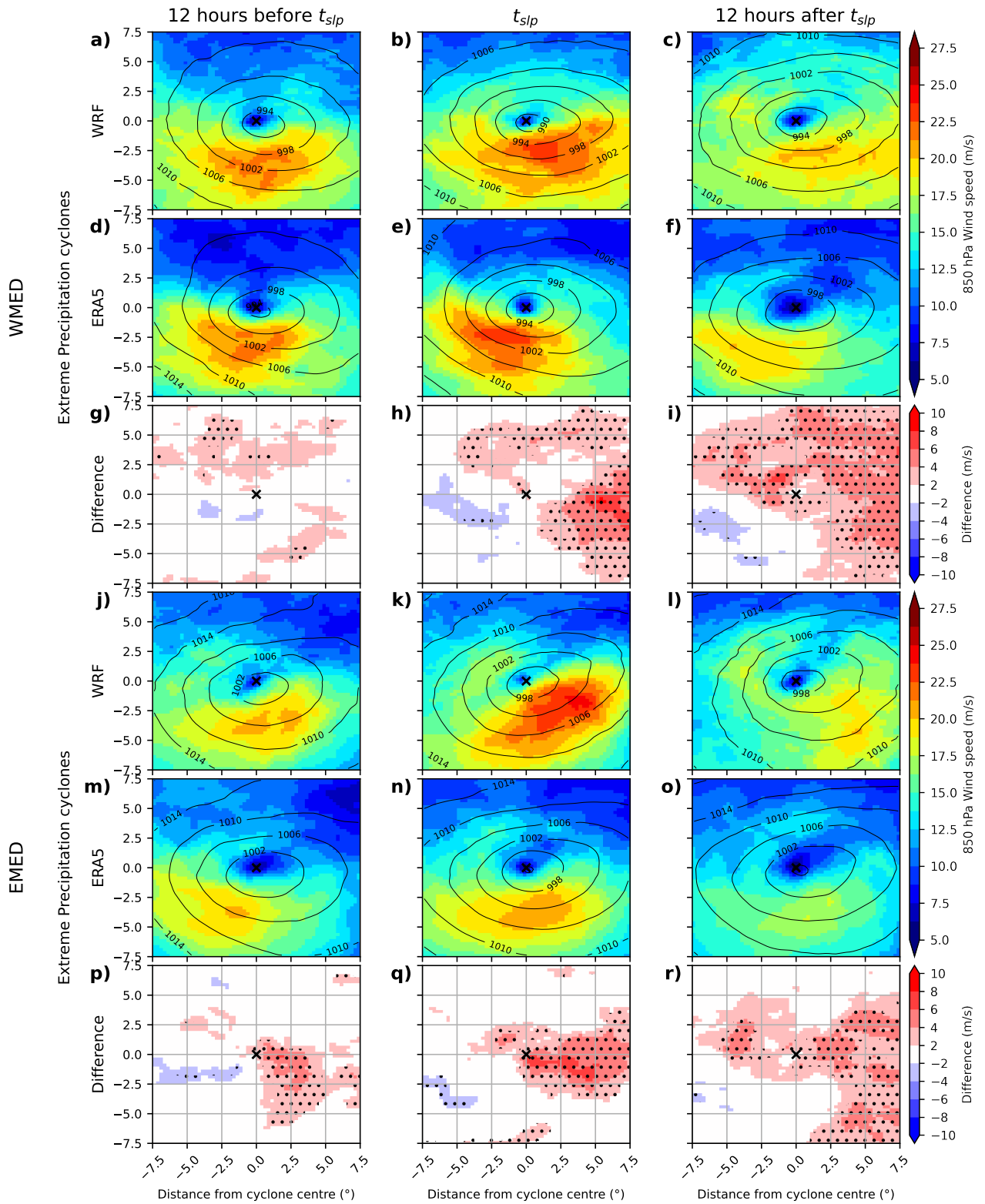


Figure S3. Same as Fig. 7, but now we compare WRF against ERA5 for the period 1981-2010.

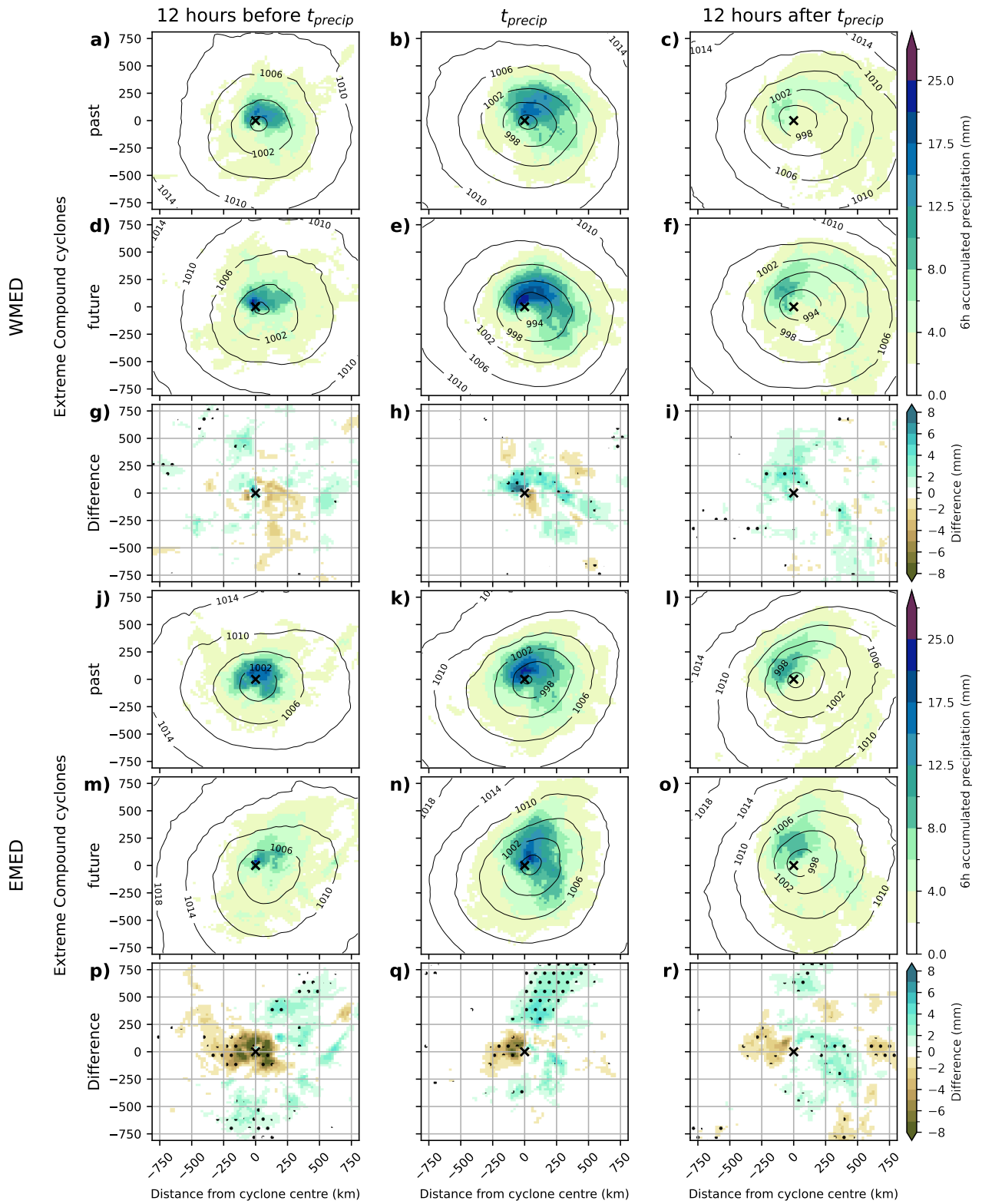


Figure S4. Same as Fig. 5, but now for compounding EXCs.

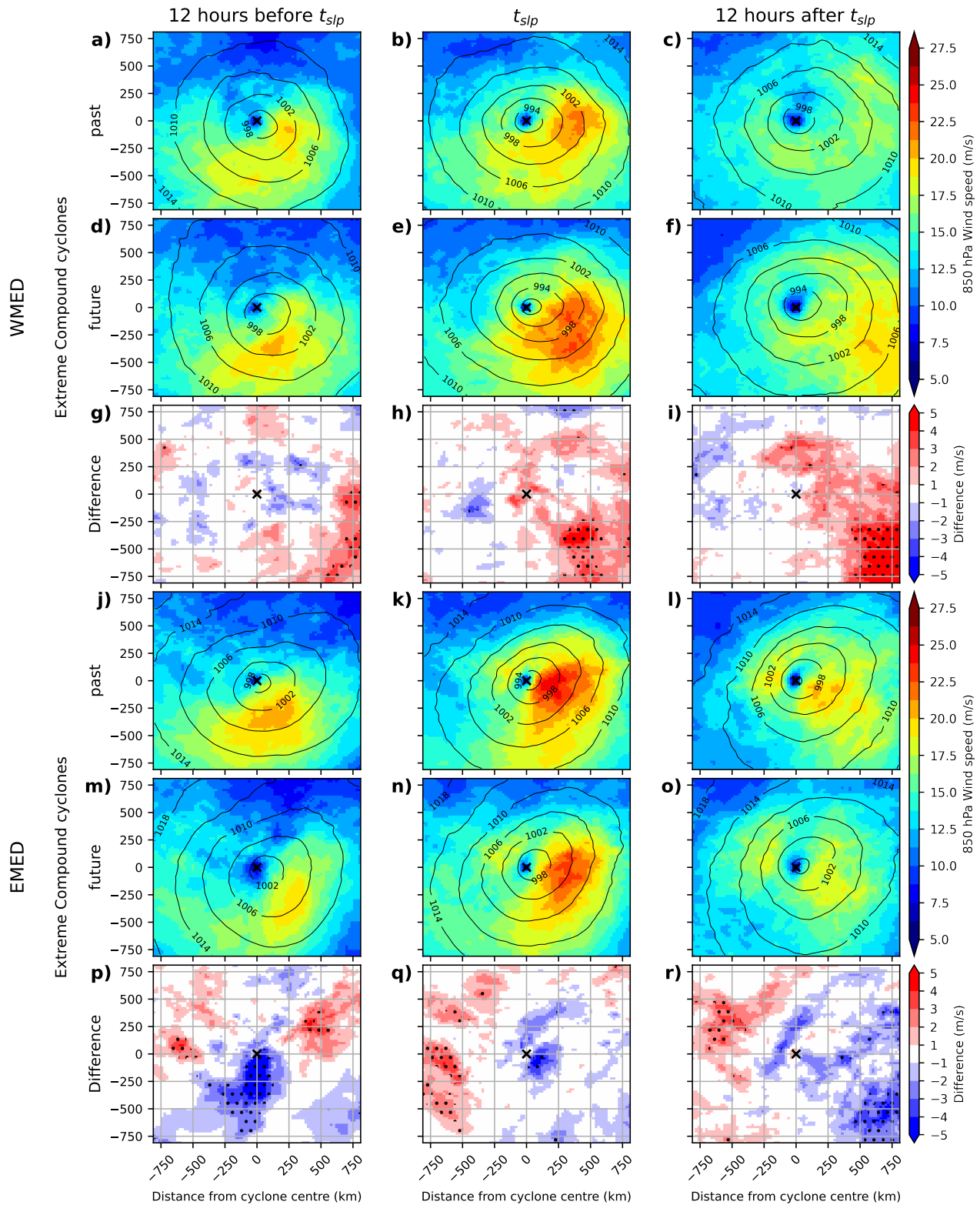


Figure S5. Same as Fig. 7, but now for compounding EXCs

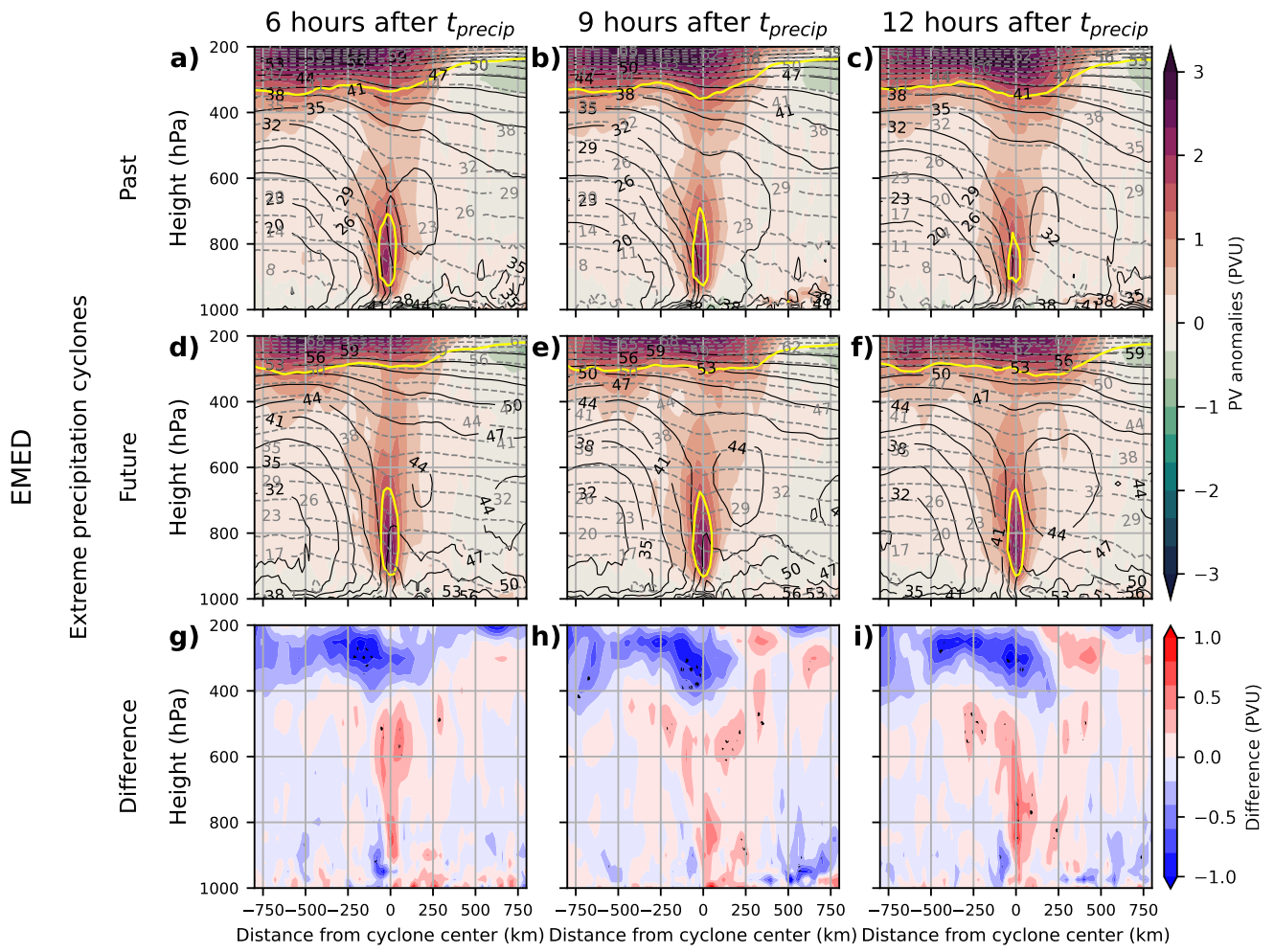


Figure S6. Same as Fig. 6, but now for precipitation EXCs in the EMED.
