## Reviewer comment:

The revised manuscript and the author's comments have resolved, addressed and/or clarified all of the potential issues raised during revision. In this sence, the article is ready for publication. That said, some of the figures could use some adjustments for clarification. Especially figures 5, 6, 7 and 9 need some bigger fonts and at times thicker lines for readability. Consider rearranging some of the multi-panel figures (6,7 in particular, 1,2 potentially) to allow some larger panels and the opportunity to leave out repetitive colour scales. In terms of contents, scales and colour maps, the figures work very well as they are.

The panels comprising Figures 1, 2, 6 and 7 have been rearranged to allow for bigger panels and to reduce the number of colour bars that need to be shown. In addition, title font size, colour bar tick size and label font sizes have also been increased for figures 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7. The bar widths for Figure 5 have also been increased, and the text font size on the panels has been increased. The text in the figure captions has been updated to reflect these changes where necessary, and in-text references to specific panels of figures have been updated to reflect the new panel labels on figures where panels have been re-arranged.
